Congratulations on your new wood floor. The following is a few simple steps to remember. Relax and enjoy your lifetime wood floor!

## Do

1. Sweep, vacuum or dust mop your floor regularly. Use only the brush attachments for the vacuum, the beater bar is for carpets only.
2. For polyurethane or acrylic finishes, spray on special wood cleaners or water and dry mop.
3. Food spills or stains can simply be wiped clean using a damp cloth. The cloth should be wrung out completely and should not be soaking wet. Dry the area thoroughly.
4. Have a good walk off mats at the entrance to an area of wood flooring. Sand and dirt act like sandpaper on wood. If wood flooring has been installed in the kitchen area, place a good non-slip mat in front of the sink.
5. Install proper floor glides on all furniture and make sure the floor glides are kept clean. Use commercially made felt protectors or wide plastic furniture casters.

## Don't

1. Do not walk on wood floors with high heels that are in disrepair (i.e. with the nail exposed) The nail head on a heel can damage even concrete.
2. Never use soaps, detergents, oil soaps, paste wax or wax removers on polyurethane or acrylic finished wood flooring. These could damage the finish and make any future re-coats difficult.
3. Do not slide heavy appliances directly on wood floor. Teflon glides are available or a piece of heavy cardboard works well.
